78. Columbia Valley Syrah, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington, 2017 (VE)

The fruit is harvested from the Wahluke Slope vineyards, a site with ideal growing conditions for traditional Rhône varieties giving a fruit-forward style

31. Marama Sauvignon Blanc Organic, Seresin Estate, Marlborough, 2016 (VE) (OR)

3. Prosecco NV Stelle d'Italia

A lively, crisp Prosecco, with a delicate lemon character and hints of fresh green pears on the palate

6. Perrier Jouët NV Grand Brut

The palate is impetuous yet full, with a cheerful vitality due to its persistent stream of sprightly bubbles

7. Perrier Jouët, NV Blason Rosé Brut

Intense, luminous salmon pink with coppery highlights and a steady stream of fine bubbles, the crunchy red fruit and citrus flavours show a delicate balance and great length

8. Perrier Jouët, 2012 Belle Epoque

Magnificent greenish gold in colour, the palate confirms the complexity and richness of the bouquet with an initial lively freshness leading into a rounded palate

Hambleton

Hambleton is one of the oldest vineyards in England, starting in 1952. From the long line of heritage to the chalky sub-strata of the South Downs, Hambleton excel in making premium wines directly comparable to that of Champagne.

4. Hambleton Classic Cuvée Brut (ENG)

Floral and stone fruit aromas; a vivid wine, well-structured with ripe acidity and a lasting finish

5. Hambleton Classic Cuvée Rosé (ENG)

The palate is rich, flavours of strawberry balanced by zingy cranberry with a smooth and creamy texture

21. Chardonnay, Vinamar, Casablanca Valley, 2018

Hand harvested from Casablanca Valley, this wine delivers fresh fruitiness with a long-lasting finish

22. Vinho Verde, Quinta da Lix, Portugal, 2020 (VE)

Fresh floral notes followed by a smooth palate of peach with a substantial finish

24. Pinot Grigio Arcole, Sartori, Veneto, 2019 (VE)

White pears and flowery notes on the nose, soft and fresh on the palate

25. Picpoul de Pinet, Reserve Roquemoliere, Languedoc, 2019 (VE)

70. Carignan/Grenache, Vin de France, La Lande, South West France, 2019

Deep garnet in colour with a spicy ripe nose. The palate is rich with ripe fruit character and a hint of peppery spice

73. Cuma Organic Malbec, El Esteco, Salta, 2019 (OR)

Made with organically grown grapes, this savoury red wine is a thrilling mix of dark, brooding fruit and is fragrant with punchy spice

75. Humberto Canale Estate Pinot Noir, Patagonia, Argentina 2019

Coming from a small winery in Patagonia is a beautiful pinot with hints of spice and smooth vanilla from 7 months in French oak casks

77. Plumbago Nero d'Avola Sicilia DOC, Planeta, Sicily, 2018 (VE)

Rosé Wines

61. Rosé Sicilia doc, Planeta, Sicily, 2019 (VE)

Inspired by a pink Sicilian sunset, this wine has a light and attractive nose with notes of rose petals, pomegranate and strawberries. On the palate, the wine is silky smooth, light and fresh

60. La Lande, Cinsault Rosé, Vin de France, South West France, 2020 (VE)

Dry and delicate rose from Languedoc, dry and refreshing from a renowned wine maker

62. Rosé de Léoube Organic, Chateau Léoube, Provence, 2019 (OR)

A truly delicate wine, with aromas of mint from the wild herbs growing around the vineyard, even sea air has its effect as well as the 25-year-old vines

63. Porte Noire Rosé Organic, Chateau Sainte Marguerite, 2019 (VE) (OR)

A collaboration between Chateau Ste Marguerite and Idris Elba. Certified Organic, Symphonie is clear and bright with a light pink hue. Floral and delicate with aromas of white flowers and passion fruit.

64. Porte Noire Rosé Organic Magnum, Chateau Sainte Marguerite, 2019 (VE) (OR)

A collaboration between Chateau Ste Marguerite and Idris Elba. Certified Organic, Symphonie is clear and bright with a light pink hue. This is a magnum of the above premium rosé

White Wines

21. Chardonnay, Vinamar, Casablanca Valley, 2018

Hand Harvested from Casablanca valley, this wine delivers fresh fruitiness with a long-lasting finish

Can be enjoyed with an array of dishes, poultry and fish being the ultimate pairings

22. Vinho Verde, Quinta do Lixa, Portugal, 2020

Fresh floral notes followed by a smooth palate of peach with a substantial finish. This amazing wine comes with

a natural spritz, adding a whole new depth to an amazing drinking wine

23. Viognier Pays d'Oc, Leduc, Languedoc, 2020 (VE)

A vibrant, luminous colour with green hues. On the nose, peach, apricot and almond aromas prevail

with a refreshing yet fruity palate with a smooth and round finish

24. Pinot Grigio Arcole, Sartori, Veneto, 2019

White pears and flowery notes on the nose, soft and fresh on the palate. Pairs perfectly with fish dishes,

as well as a sunny day out on the Terrace

25. Picpoul de Pinet, Reserve Roquemoliere, Languedoc, 2019 (VE)

Crystal clear wine with light green hints, soft nose with a zesty palate. One of the most popular wines of recent years, a bowl of mussels or white fish suits this wine perfectly

26. Petit Chenin Blanc, Ken Forrester Wines, Western Cape, 2019 (VE)

A youthful fresh wine with quince and pear drops flavours. Real freshness on the palate with crunchy green apple and grapefruit flavours. Good mouthfeel and appetisingly tangy finish

27. Land Made Sauvignon Blanc, Yealands, Marlborough, 2019 (VE)

Notes of guava and stone fruits bursting with flavour but delivering a crisp, mineral finish

28. Albarino, Eidosela, Rias Baixas, 2019 (VE)

Wonderfully aromatic, exhibiting a freshness with hints of apricot and peach. Nicely balanced,

with a good length and texture on the palate

White Wines

29. Columbia Valley Chardonnay, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington, 2018

Cool-climate Chardonnay from Washington State, soft with sweet citrus and red apples, uplifted by a fragrant scattering of spice

31. Marama Sauvignon Blanc Organic, Seresin Estate, Marlborough, 2016 (VE) (OR)

Sourced from our old vines that thrive on river silt terraces in the Central Wairau Valley, more sophisticated than many: there's gooseberry and a spritz of citrus but also soft yellow peaches

32. Sancerre Les Grandmontains Blanc, Domaine Laporte, Loire, 2019 (VE) (OR)

A delicate aroma of ripe fruit, a mouthful of pears with a spray of lemon and a freshness that's almost menthol characterise this fine Sancerre from a top producer

33. Planeta Chardonnay, Sicily, 2019 (VE)

A rich, golden Chardonnay that bundles yellow peaches, acacia honey and a touch of marzipan into a net of fine-thread acidity, then hits you with a homely waft of toast, a truly beautiful wine

34. Condrieu La Petite Côte, Yves Cuilleron, Rhone, 2018 (VE)

The grapes are harvested by hand, when you see the precipitous slopes of the appellation you can see why. All the wines are fermented in French oak barrels, producing a wine with alluring Condrieu, perfumed with pineapple, hay and herbs

35. Chassagne-Montrachet Blanc, Joseph Drouhin, Burgundy, 2017

Light golden colour. Intense nose of flower, brioche, and candied lemon aromas. Good texture and finesse on the palate

36. Riesling Cuvée Frédéric Emile, Trimbach, Alsace, 2012 (VE)

The top cuvée of a great estate, this has nuts and lime, richness yet a backbone of steel., delicious with fish and poultry

37. Chardonnay, Planeta, Magnum, 2018 (VE)

A rich, golden Chardonnay that bundles yellow peaches, acacia honey and a touch of marzipan into a net of fine-thread acidity, then hits you with a homely waft of toast.

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Red Wines

70. Carignan/Grenache, Vin de France, La Lande, South West France, 2019

Deep garnet in colour with a spicy ripe nose; the palate is rich with ripe fruit characters

71. Merlot, Vinamar, Casablanca Valley, 2019

Red ruby colour with light purple hues, intense aroma of blackberry and plum. Medium body, soft tannins and a round finish

(Bottle - 26)

72. Red Boar Bobal, Bodegas Gallegas, Atlantic, 2018

Spicy Spanish Bobal, a juicy native grape, brimming with raspberry and red plum and fragrant with nutmeg.

Recommended with hearty dishes of red meat and vegetables.

73. Cuma Organic Malbec, El Esteco, Salta, 2019 (OR) (VE)

Made with organically grown grapes, brooding fruit with a fragrant punchy spice, the vineyards are based upon deep, poor and sandy loam soils with irrigation from the Andes.

74. Rioja Crianza, Ramon Bilbao, Rioja, 2017 (VE)

Rioja from a respected producer, full of black fruit plus an intriguing sour note, so that added to the sweetness of blackberries and blackcurrants comes the tang of blackberry yoghurt.

75. Humberto Canale Estate Pinot Noir, Patagonia, Argentina 2019

Coming from a small winery in Patagonia is a beautiful pinot with hints of spice and smooth vanilla from 7 months in French oak casks

76. L'Étoile de Villegeorge, Château de Villegeorge Haut Medoc, Bordeaux, 2018

Dark, deep red colour. Nose is expressive of berries and flowers. On the palate the wine is soft well-rounded with a beautiful harmony between power and velvety ripe tannins.

77. Plumbago Nero d'Avola Sicilia DOC, Planeta, Sicily, 2018 (VE)

Plumbago is dominated by aromas of ripe plums and wild blackberries with hints of incense, jasmine and black truffle.

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Red Wines

78. Columbia Valley Syrah, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington, 2017 (VE)

79. Unravelled Pinot Noir, Carrick Winery, 2018 (VE)

Charming and fragrant, full of berries and black cherries, with a hint of vanilla from well-judged use of oak. Beautifully paired with duck or game dishes, or a selection of local chesses to enjoy in the lounge

80. Rioja Reserva, Sierra Cantabria, 2014

Full-bodied Rioja, packed with cherries and heady with flower petals, the whole given depth and seriousness by whiffs of tobacco, cedar and toasty oak

81. Barolo DOCG, Ascheri, 2016 (VE)

Rich and fragrant Barolo, heady with sweet spice and leather, with a delicious chewiness reminiscent of underbrush and dried flowers. The vines are trained with the traditional Guyot simple system and the grapes are all picked by hand

82. Amarone Valpantena DOCG, Bertani, 2017 (VE)

Deep dark ruby with a violet rim. Notes of black and sour cherries, berries, spices and dried fruit Grapes are harvested by hand from wholly owned vineyards on the hills of Valpantena cru of Valpolicella

83. Gevrey Chambertin, Joseph Drouhin, Burgundy, 2016

A beautiful, bright ruby colour. Intensely fruity on the nose. As the wine evolves, there are more complex notes, such as mild spice, nutmeg and leather.

84. Artemis Cabernet Sauvignon, Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, 2017

An utterly delicious Napa Valley Cabernet, reminiscent of a Saint-Julien Bordeaux from a rich, rounded vintage. Blueberry and black cherry fruit greet you as you put your nose in the glass

85. Margaux Château Durfort-Vivens - 2ème Cru Classé, 2011 (VE)

Richly textured Bordeaux red, packed with redcurrants and blueberries and fragrant with violets and a faint perfume of tobacco. The magnificent terroir enables an early optimal ripening of the Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, thereby allowing a full expression of the finesse and silkiness of the tannins

86. Artemis Cabernet Sauvignon, Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, 2016

An utterly delicious Napa Valley Cabernet, reminiscent of a Saint-Julien Bordeaux from a rich, rounded vintage.
