Our Personal Favourites

Hambledon Classic Cuvee Brut NV

From the oldest commercial vineyard in England comes a vibrant and refreshing wine with some complexity.

Estate Pinot Noir, Humberto Canale 2018

Coming from a small winery in Patagonia is a beautiful pinot with hints of spice and smooth vanilla from 7 months in French oak casks.

Sparkling

Prosecco NV Stelle d'Italia

A lively, crisp Prosecco, with a delicate lemon character and hints of fresh green pears on the palate

Perrier Jouet NV Grand Brut

The palate is impetuous yet full, with a cheerful vitality due to its persistent stream of sprightly bubbles

Intense, luminous salmon pink with coppery highlights and a steady stream of fine bubbles, the crunchy red fruit and citrus flavours show a delicate balance and great length

Magnificent greenish gold in colour, the palate confirms the complexity and richness of the bouquet with an initial lively freshness leading into a rounded palate

Hambleton

Hambleton is one of the oldest vineyards in England, starting in 1952. From the long line of heritage to the chalky sub-strata of the South Downs, Hambleton excel in making premium wine's directly comparable to that of Champagne.

Floral and stone fruit aromas; a vivid wine, well-structured with ripe acidity and a lasting finish

Rose Sicilia doc, Planeta, Sicily, 2018

Light and delicate rose from Languedoc, dry and refreshing from a renowned wine maker

Carignan/Grenache, Vin de France, La Lande, South West France, 2018

Deep garnet in colour with a spicy ripe nose. The palate is rich with ripe fruit character and a hint of peppery spice

Cuma Organic Malbec, El Esteco, Salta, 2018

Made with organically grown grapes, this savoury red wine is a thrilling mix of dark, brooding fruit and fragrant with punchy spice

Rioja Crianza, Ramon Bilbao, Rioja, 2016

Wonderfully aromatic, exhibiting a freshness with hints of apricot and peach. Nicely balanced, with a good length and texture on the palate

Deep garnet in colour with a spicy ripe nose; the palate is rich with ripe fruit character

Cuma Organic Malbec, El Esteco, Salta, 2018

Made with organically grown grapes, brooding fruit with a fragrant punchy spice

Rioja Crianza, Ramon Bilbao, Rioja, 2016

Medium intensity of aromas with fresh dark fruit, such as blackberries and blackcurrants

Plumbago Nero d'Avola Sicilia DOC, Planeta, Sicily, 2017

Plumbago is dominated by aromas of ripe plums and wild blackberries with hints of incense, jasmine and black truffle.

Red Boar Bobal, Bodegas Gallegas, Atlantic, 2018

On the palate it is soft, silky and well-balanced with ripe fruit and pleasant herbal notes

Merlot, Vinamar, Casablanca Valley, 2019

Red ruby colour with light purple hues, intense aroma of blackberry and plum. Medium body, soft tannins and a round finish
(Bottle - £24)

L'Étoile de Villegeorge, Château Villegeorge, Bordeaux, 2016

Dark, deep red colour. Nose is expressive of berries and flowers. On the palate the wine is soft well-rounded with a beautiful harmony between power and velvety ripe tannins.

Columbia Valey Syrah, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington, 2016

The fruit is harvested from the Wahluke Slope vineyards, a site with ideal growing conditions for traditional Rhône varieties giving a fruit-forward style

Gevrey Chambertin, Joseph Drouhin, Burgundy, 2016

A beautiful, bright ruby colour. Intensely fruity on the nose. As the wine evolves, there are more complex notes, such as mild spice, nutmeg and leather.
